BYLAW 01/07
A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH RULES FOR CONDUCT OF
COUNCILORS AND THE CONDUCT OF MEMBERS OF COUNCIL
COMMITTEES

The council for the Town of Hanley in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

General Duties of Councilors:

- (a) to represent the public and to consider the well-being and interest of the municipality
- (b) to participate in developing and evaluating the policies, services and programs of the municipality:
- (c) to participate in council meetings and council committee meetings and meetings of other bodies to which are appointed by council:
- (d) to ensure that administrative practices and procedures are in place to implement the decisions of council;
- (e) **to keep in confidence matters discussed in private at a council or council committee meeting until discussed at a meeting held in public;**
- (f) to perform any other duty or function imposed on councilors by this or any other Act or by the council

- (g) Contravention of the above bylaw results in disqualification of the council member. The said council member will then be removed from council and will not be eligible to be nominated or elected for three consecutive years after the disqualification.

This disqualification will in turn cause a vacancy on council and subject to section 160.07(1) of the Local Government Election Act Division 2.
