

BYLAW NO. 5/13

TOWN OF HANLEY

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A DISTRICT BOARD OF REVISION

The Council for the Town of Hanley, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. DEFINITIONS

In this bylaw:

- a) "Council" means the council of the Town of Hanley;
- b) "District Board of Revision" means the District Board of Revision as established under the provision of section 222(1) of *The Municipalities Act*;
- c) "Board" means the appointees of the Board of Revision;

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bylaw is to enable the council to enter an agreement with neighbouring municipalities to establish a District Board of Revision.

3. APPOINTMENT TO BOARD

The council may appoint one person to the board.

4. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

The terms of the agreement are defined in the memorandum of agreement which is identified as Exhibit "A" and is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.
