

**BYLAW NO 6/12**

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF HANLEY TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH OTHER MUNICIPALITIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT APPEALS BOARD**

The Council of the Town of Hanley, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. DEFINITIONS

In this bylaw:

- a) "Council" means the council of the Town of Hanley;
- b) "Board" means the District Development Appeals Board established pursuant to Section 214(3) of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*;

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bylaw is to enable the council to enter an agreement with interested municipalities with membership in the WaterWolf District Planning Commission to establish a District Development Appeals Board.

3. MUNICIPAL MEMBERSHIP ON DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT APPEALS BOARD

- a) The Town of Hanley is hereby authorized to create a district development appeals board in conjunction with other interested municipalities belonging to the WaterWolf District Planning Commission;
- b) The district development appeals board created pursuant to subsection 3(a) shall be known as the "WaterWolf Planning District Development Appeals Board".

4. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

The terms of the agreement are defined in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
