

BYLAW NO. 9/10

BYLAW TO REPEAL BYLAWS

The Council for the Town of Hanley, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

That the following bylaws be repealed:

1. Bylaw No. 4/67 being a bylaw dealing with the erection and licensing of signboards and billboards in the corporate limits of Hanley;
2. Bylaw No. 2/76 being a bylaw to provide for the keeping of pounds in the Town of Hanley;
3. Bylaw No. 7/79 being a bylaw to enter into an agreement to provide road ambulance service;
4. Bylaw No. 8/79 being a bylaw to provide for licensing of occupants of trailers, mobile homes and portable shacks;
5. Bylaw No. 2/97 being a bylaw to allow for the use of tax tools;
6. Bylaw No. 3/09 being a bylaw to extend the time required for the completion of the Assessment Roll;
7. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
