

BYLAW NO. 9/17

BYLAW TO REPEAL BYLAWS

The Council for the Town of Hanley, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1) That the following bylaws be repealed:
 1. Bylaw No. 7/78 being a bylaw to close a lane;
 2. Bylaw No. 10/79 being a bylaw to regulate the installation of plumbing within the Town, subject to regulations under the provisions of the public health act of the Province of Saskatchewan;
 3. Bylaw No. 2/81 being a bylaw to close a lane;
 4. Bylaw No. 4/82 being a bylaw to close a lane;
 5. Bylaw No. 6/82 being a bylaw to close a street;
 6. Bylaw No. 5/83 being a bylaw to repeal bylaws;
 7. Bylaw No. 6/84 being a bylaw to repeal bylaw 2/65;
 8. Bylaw No. 4/97 being a bylaw to close a public roadway;
 9. Bylaw No. 6/09 being a bylaw to repeal bylaws;
 10. Bylaw No. 9/10 being a bylaw to repeal bylaws;
 11. Bylaw No. 8/13 being a bylaw to repeal bylaws;
 12. Bylaw No. 11/16 being a bylaw to repeal bylaws;
 13. Bylaw No. 1/17 being a bylaw to repeal a bylaw.

- 2) This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
