The Town Office has summarized the Capital Expenses for 2010.

- 1) The Campground project was completed over two years at a cost of \$33,745. A grant was received for \$30,370 and the Rec Board covered the remaining cost of \$3,375.00. This was a project that will hopefully increase camping visitors to our community!
- 2) A camper trailer and new sign were purchased at the transfer station. Our permit requires that the transfer station is manned so now employees have somewhere warm in the winter. The cost of the camper and sign were \$1,920. This cost was covered 100% by New Deal Gas Tax Funding.
- 3) Sewer Snake – We are now able to provide a safe and efficient method of cleaning out sewer lines. The sewer snake cost \$3,337.
- 4) Lift Station Alarm, Backup System and replacement of pumps – We are now able to run a generator in the event of power failure. The alarm system telephones the operator if there is a problem in the plant. The total cost of this project was \$21,924. We will have received \$18,965 in New Deal Gas Tax Funding for this project therefore costing the town \$2,959.
- 5) Badly needed Office Furniture making the office very professional looking cost \$6,195.
- 6) Culverts for a cost of \$3,530.
- 7) The Electronic Meter project was a two year project that in total cost \$125,002. New Deal Gas Tax Funding and Municipal Economic Enhancement Funding was received in the amount of \$113,868 leaving the town's cost of \$11,134.

TOWN OF HANLEY
Development & Building Permit Approval Process

- Step 1** Applicant to allow 2 – 3 months or more lead time prior to project start (digging the hole) to arrange for property plans to be drawn up (ie: architectural, structural & site plan) before applying for a building permit.
- Step 2** Obtain an application for a development permit. Fill it out and be sure to include the site plan required. The purpose of the development permit is to ensure that what you are proposing falls into the property zoning for your property., There is no cost for this permit, but it is required prior to applying for a building permit. If what you are proposing falls under a discretionary use in the zoning bylaw, then the application must be submitted to Council for their consideration. Administration cannot grant a permit for a discretionary use. If the permit is approved, you can then proceed to the next step of applying for a building permit.
- Step 3** Gather the right number of plans as per the checklist included in this package, then submit to the Town of Hanley to start the permit approval process. Foundation plans are required to be stamped by a structural engineer. The **only deviation** from this requirement is if the foundation is to be built on a slab.
- Step 4** The Town will then send the application and plans to Meridan Inspections Ltd. for a plan review.
- Step 5** The building official reviews the plans, looking for National Building Code infractions, list Notes for the builder to change or introduce when building. The turn around time of this step is dependent on the workload of the municipality administration/building official, council meeting and the mailing time.
- Step 6** The building official returns the reviewed submission (including one set of the plans) to the Town. The Town then notifies you that the permit is formally approved by the municipal administration, pending payment of the permit fee.

NOTE: The building official requires two sets of plans. The Town cannot submit the application until two sets of plans are submitted. The same holds true for having foundation plans having to be stamped by a structural engineer. Please be advised that while you may not agree with these policies, they are necessary to avoid future liability.

Notes from the Town Office

The Town Office is conducting an informal survey on whether or not we should provide recycling services through All-Green Recycling. Loraas would pick up garbage every other week from the existing black bins and All-Green would pick up the recycle bins on the alternate weeks from the new blue bins. The total cost for both services is \$11.35. As you will have noticed in our financial report on solid waste management, we were in a deficit. Your Town taxes are paying for the deficit.

If you have not already done so, please contact the Town Office to give us your input. Hopefully with your help, a decision can be made by the end of June.

Remember to move your carts back to a safe place on your property following their pickup. This helps our Foreman to continue to do an excellent job of street maintenance.

We seem to have a number of dogs running at large throughout the Town. Please remember to be a responsible pet owner and keep your dogs leashed or confined to your yard. If you have not purchased your 2011 dog or cat license, please do so at the Town Office.

The transfer station will be open for summer hours, Tuesday and Thursday from 5:00 pm to 9:00 pm (or dark) and Saturday from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm, beginning in the next few weeks, whenever the snow is gone and the ground is dry. Check at the office or at the transfer station if you aren't sure.

Please trim hedges this spring.

There is a bylaw to keep vehicles off the street. Streets cannot be maintained properly if there are vehicles on boulevards.

The Town now has a Facebook page. Be sure to “Like” us and check it frequently for updates.

If committees or service clubs are changing contact people, please contact the Town Office. I don’t have contacts for Hanley Lutheran Church.

Adam Toth, Jr. Community Planner for WaterWolf, met with the Administrator at the Town Office to work on our Official Community Plan and review our needs for a new Zoning Bylaw.

The Town applied for and will be receiving funding from the “Emergency Flood Damage Reduction Funding Program” for the clearing of channels and culverts. The water seems to be flowing very well through Town and hopefully we do not have the flood problems we had in 2010.

Remember to pay your water bills within 20 days of the billing date!

The Town Office will be closed April 21, 25, and 26 for Administrator’s holidays.
