- Min 127/08 Grindheim/Ballard moved that the minutes of the August meeting be approved as submitted. Carried.
  - Finstat 128/08 Ballard/DeRegt moved that the statement of accounts for the month of August be approved. Carried.
  - Resignation 129/08 Ballard/Grindheim moved that with the acceptance of the resignation received from Don Lynn, we appoint Dwight Thall be appointed as interim Mayor. Carried.  
130/08 Ballard/DeRegt moved that Daryl Grindheim be appointed as Deputy Mayor. Carried.
