**SNOW**

When moving snow from your driveway, please pile the snow on your lawn especially if your street has already been cleared. If you pile it on the street after it has been cleared, the snow creates an obstruction for any travelers down your street. Thank you from the Town Office and Foreman.

**GRAVEL**

The Town has a limited stockpile of gravel so if you require gravel, please contact the Town Office and the foreman will determine if or when he can deliver it.

**POLICY**

For purposes of safety on street corners, the Town Council passed the following policy:

Corner Visibility Triangles – On a corner lot in any district, no hedge, planting, tree, fence or other structure not being a building shall be erected, placed, or maintained within the triangular area formed by the intersecting property lines and the straight line joining said property lines at points which are 6.0 metres distant from the point of intersection, measure along said property lines, to a height greater than 1.0 metres.

**NOTES FROM THE TOWN OFFICE**

In **September**, the Town Council reviewed the weight restriction bylaw again to allow the STC buses, Loraas Disposal trucks supplying services to the 200 and 300 block of Lincoln St., emergency vehicles and residential delivery vehicles supplying services to the 200 and 300 block of Lincoln St. All other vehicles over 8000 kg must reroute to the north and take Washington Ave. or to the south to take Grant St. This bylaw is in place to protect the paving that was finished on Lincoln St. this summer. The paving on the entire street (other than the access road) was a \$200,000 project so let's make sure we can keep it in good shape for the future.

The Policy Manual was amended to include sections on the installation of water and sewer utility services and drainage requirements. These policies will apply to new construction and are included in the new building permit application packages. If you would like a copy, please contact the Town Office.

The Town Council continues to manage infrastructure by contracting McGill's Industrial to flush sewer mains. This will be a three year project with one-third of the Town's sewer mains being done each year with the lift station attended to in the third year.

On September 19, nomination day came and went with all members of Council acclaimed. Four Councillors and the Mayor were incumbents; Russell King and Andrea Townsend are new.

The Town of Hanley hosted CTV Saskatoon for their fall Home Town Tour on Friday, Sept. 21. It was an enjoyable and busy afternoon.

In **October**, the Council learned that we were approved through the Provincial Disaster Assistance Program to repair Railway St. An extension was requested so we can discover how best to address the repairs to that street.

The Town Council supported the application to the Community Infrastructure Improvement Fund by the Hanley Curling Club for repairs to the header pipes. These repairs have been started to discover that the pumps needed major repairs also. The Curling Club is soliciting donations for this project to keep our rink open. We have the only curling ice in the area so be sure to support the facility!

The Council also accepted an offer to purchase "Duncan Acres" from Agvantage Development Corporation. They are an agriculture based commercial entity. You should see some action on that land as early as spring of 2013.

In **November**, our "new" council was sworn in and the two new members jumped in with both feet. Richard McGregor was appointed Deputy Mayor for a period of one year. The Council approved, and Foreman Ben Collins agreed, that a work placement student accompany the foreman for a week to see what maintenance is involved in municipal government.

As there is now a house going up in the Dietz subdivision, Council adopted a civic addressing bylaw to appoint house numbers to the lots in the subdivision.

The Town Council "considered the possibilities" again and approval was granted to SaskTel to install a stealth pole that will enhance wireless service to the Town of Hanley.

The backup generator arrived that will be connected in the spring to the water distribution plant. This generator will start up automatically in the event of a power failure to avoid depressurization in the water mains.

You may have noticed a grey box on a couple of light standards. Through the Community Consultative Group, the Council requested the RCMP to install a speed camera to determine the average speed of vehicles on key streets. The results will be presented to Council following this trial period.
