### ***NOTES FROM THE TOWN OFFICE***

In July, HJR Asphalt came to finish the Town's paving project on Lincoln St. and extended the paving to Highway 11. The access road paving was a result of being one of 8 communities in the Province selected to have their access roads improved. This initiative was because of an application to the Ministries of Tourism and Highways & Infrastructure.

While the HJR Asphalt crew was here, the Outdoor Recreational Facility (old tennis courts on the school grounds) was paved also. This is being funded in part through a Community Vitality Program grant and local donations. This project has been proceeding with the erection of 6 new basketball standards, and rubber paving on the north and south edges between the asphalt and fence. A work bee was held Tuesday, August 21, where crusher dust was laid and tamped prior to the rubber paving being laid and the fence on the east end erected. Thanks to Jim Tucker, Chad Haaland, Ken Froese and Henry Peters for their help at the work bee and a huge bouquet to Principal Chris Tucker, Vice-Principal Mark Anderson for all the volunteer hours they have put towards this Community project. The Town will still accept donations towards this project which are eligible for a charitable donation receipt for your income tax.

In August, Zac Tomlenovich from Kenaston re-shingled the roof of the Library and Western Urethane was contracted for roof repair of the water distribution plant. The improvement to the water plant infrastructure should be completed in September.

Quotations were received for a backup generator at the water plant that will turn the distribution pumps on automatically in the event of a power failure thereby preventing depressurization of the lines which would result in having a precautionary boil water advisory.

On the topic of precautionary boil water advisories, we seemed to have a number of incidents this summer with water line repairs, new installations and DRWU having a PDWA. Thank you for your patience during these times and remember the advisories are "Precautionary". The Ministry of Environment is very stringent in their mandate to provide the people of Saskatchewan with clean, safe water and we should be thankful for their diligence.

Policies seem to be a part of life for Council and Administration. Currently, Administration is drafting a policy in regards to water and sewer installations with drainage requirements. The draft will be reviewed at the September meeting of council.

Remember that 2012 is a Municipal Election year. Nomination forms are available for Council and Mayor at the Town Office and on our website under the "Election 2012" tab. Nomination forms will be accepted at the Town Office during regular business hours each day until September 18 and all day September 19 till 4:00 p.m. Nomination forms can be presented to the returning officer or a nomination officer by the candidate or a person acting on his or her behalf. Election Day is October 24, 2012.

Hanley has been chosen as one of the communities for the CTV Hometown Tour. On Friday Sept. 21, CTV will visit our community for a tour, interview a few individuals and do a live broadcast while here.

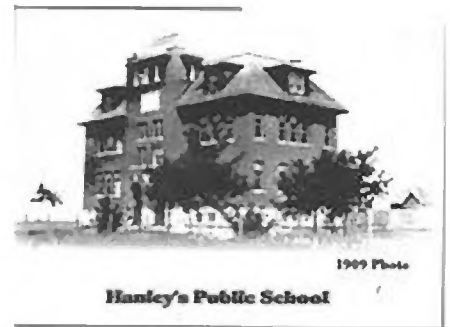
