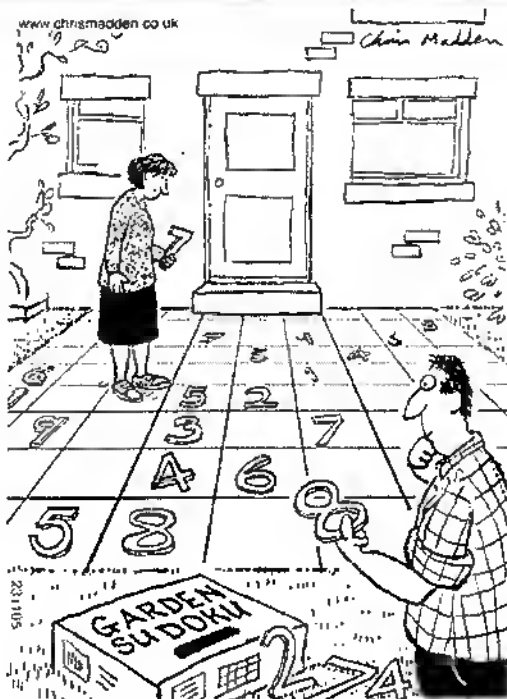
Also a big thanks to the Lutheran church, who this year opened their doors to the pre-school and allowed us to have classes in their church. It has been a wonderful place for the children to come.

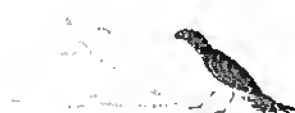

On April 29, 2008, we had a brief, informal meeting. Our projects this year are limited, as we rely on volunteer help, and have been short in that area for a couple of years.

Over the winter if there is volunteer interest we may start to build the silhouette (we have some boards from the Pool Elevator demolition).

The flowerpots that are at the Cenotaph Park and the Hanley Sign will be planted again this year. We will provide the plants and will require volunteers to plant and water over the summer.

The group needs a volunteer list that we can call when small projects need done or items repaired or a bench installed. Please call Glenda if you can spare an hour here and there.

We will still take orders for planting trees, installing benches, depending on the location, help required and time frame.

## Hanley Centennial Hall Report

The annual meeting of the hall board was held on April 10, 2008

Highlights included:

- 1. - Treasurer's Report-
- a. Revenue was \$44,966.77 in 2007.
- b. Expenditures-\$45,883.05 in 2007

### Old Business

-Renewal of Caretaker's Contract effective April 1, 2008. Three people were interviewed. It was decided to award the contract to Carol Haight for one year. **New Business**

-Rental Rates -Last increase in Office rent-2003, Hall rent- 2004. After discussion a motion was made to raise rents 20% across the board beginning January 1,2009.

### Maintenance:

- A new light industrial model vacuum has been purchased.
- New blinds and curtains have been purchased as well as 80 feet of baseboard.
- A work bee is planned for Saturday, April 19, 2008 at the hall to finish painting of the doors and woodwork in the hall foyer, bathrooms and main hall as well as the stage. The new blinds and curtains rods need to be installed as well.
- The board is presently looking at ways energy can be further saved in the hall. We are looking into the cost of installing a new boiler.
- To meet fire regulations, a new Class K fire extinguisher had to be purchased and installed in the kitchen, and existing fire extinguishers were serviced.
- Thanks once again to the Hanley Legion for their support of the hall with the Club 52 draw proceeds and the donation of their Lottery grant for their generous contribution of over \$8,000.00 in 2007.

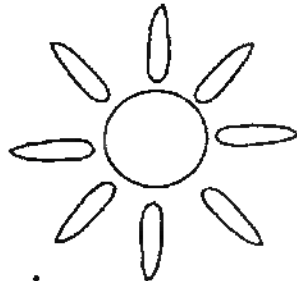
