

**BYLAW NO. 3/12**

**TOWN OF HANLEY**

**A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE TOWN OF HANLEY**

The Council of the Town of Hanley, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw, the word “firearms” shall be deemed to include any type or caliber of firearm, or any type of air gun or air pistol.
2. No person, unless authorized by this bylaw, shall discharge any type or caliber of firearm within the Town of Hanley.
3. The following persons are authorized to discharge firearms within the Town of Hanley:
  - a. Peace Officers acting in the line of duty
  - b. An employee of the Town for the purpose of controlling pests
  - c. A pest control officer appointed by resolution of Council
  - d. Persons shooting within the confines of a Government approved gun range
  - e. Persons participating in Council approved sporting events, such as turkey shoots, or similar events, upon such terms and conditions as Council stipulates
4. The Mayor or Town Administrator is hereby authorized to issue permits for the purpose of this bylaw allowing the discharge of firearms.
5. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties imposed by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Hanley.
6. Bylaw No. 2/70 is hereby repealed.
