

BYLAW NO 02 /16

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF HANLEY TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH OTHER MUNICIPALITIES FOR THE PROVISION OF MUTUAL AID IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE EMERGENCY PLANNING ACT

The Council of the Town of Hanley, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bylaw is to enable the council to enter an agreement with neighbouring municipalities for the provision of mutual aid.

2. MUNICIPAL MEMBERS

a) The Town of Hanley is hereby authorized to create a mutual aid area in conjunction with the following municipalities:

Village of Kenaston
Town of Dundurn
Resort Village of Shields
Resort Village of Thode
Village of Bradwell
Whitecap Dakota First Nations
Rural Municipality of Dundurn #314
Rural Municipality of Rosedale #283
Rural Municipality of Blucher #343
Rural Municipality of Lost River No. 313

b) The mutual aid created pursuant to subsection 2(a) shall be known as Regional Emergency Mutual Aid Cooperative (REMAC).

3. APPOINTMENT TO BOARD

The council shall appoint one representative to the board.

4. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

The terms of the agreement are defined and are identified as Schedule "A" and is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.

REGIONAL EMERGENCY MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT

WHEREAS the municipalities above mentioned deem it practical to enter into an agreement for the provision of mutual aid in accordance with section 11 of the Emergency Planning Act; and

WHEREAS all parties agree to establish and participate in a Joint Committee for the purpose of developing and implementing protocols for dealing with declared emergencies or disasters within said municipalities;

NOW THEREFORE THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH THAT:

- a. The parties agree to joint action for provision of unified and effective emergency response and preparedness through the formation of a mutual aid organization. The organization shall forthwith be known as the Regional Emergency Mutual Aid Cooperative (REMAC).
- b. REMAC shall consist of a least one representative from each of the parties entered into this agreement. The representatives should consist of a municipal elected official, a member of the party's emergency measures organization executive or planning committee, or a person or persons appointed by resolution of the respective council.
- c. The parties agree that the chairperson of REMAC shall be appointed from within the organization, and that meetings be held in a suitable administrative location chosen by the chair for each meeting.

- d. The parties agree that all residual costs incurred in the performance of Regional Emergency Mutual Aid Cooperative activities, be agreed upon prior to said activities, and shared equally among the parties on the basis of equal weight of assessment and population.
 - e. The parties agree to the development and exchange of training and planning programs, which may include resource inventories.
 - f. The parties agree that those resources allocated in the event of an emergency shall work under the direction of the requesting emergency measures organization.
 - g. The parties agree to furnish all other parties with a list of resources that may be utilized in the event of an emergency including, but not limited to:
 - i. Equipment
 - ii. Human Resources (Manpower)
 - iii. Shelter
 - iv. Telephone numbers of municipal officials
 - v. Key Personnel
 - h. The parties agree that all authorized expenses incurred by REMAC shall be paid in the first instance by the party (municipality with the emergency, and the residual financial resources, after deducting the costs from all financial assistance relative thereto received by the municipality or the Regional Emergency Mutual Aid Cooperative from other sources, shall be shared between the parties in the proportion relative to services provided.
 - i. The parties agree to coordinate meetings on a regularly scheduled basis (minimum once per annum), frequency to be determined and agreed upon by REMAC members.
 - j. The parties agree that this agreement shall be for a term of five years but shall be reviewed in the fourth year at the annual meeting. Any party to this agreement may withdraw from the agreement by giving all parties to the agreement sixty days written notice of such withdrawal.
