TOWN OF HANLEY

**A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 11/09 BEING A BYLAW TO PROVIDE
FOR ENTERING INTO AGREEMENT AND SETTING POLICIES AND
PROCEDURES FOR A WASTE TRANSFER STATION**

The Council for the Town of Hanley, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1) That Bylaw No. 11/09 be amended by deleting section 3 and by substituting the following:
 - 2) a. Containers for reception of garbage shall be kept in the bins supplied by the municipality.
 - b. A person disposing of construction waste, including shingles, shall make arrangements with either:
 - (i) the Town of Hanley for a 6-yard construction bin for small projects more specifically defined as:
 - Garages, sheds, decks, patios, and basement developments; or
 - (ii) a waste contractor for a larger construction bin.
 - c. A delivery charge of fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be payable to the Town of Hanley following the removal of the 6-yard construction bin back to the storage yard.
 - d. The fee for emptying the container shall be as invoiced by the Loraas Disposal agreement including the fuel surcharge and shall be payable to the Town of Hanley
 - d. A weekly charge of \$50 and/or monthly charge of \$200 shall be applicable for long-term usage of containers.
- 3) Bylaw No. 14/13 be hereby repealed.
